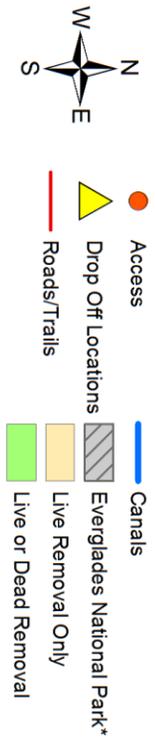
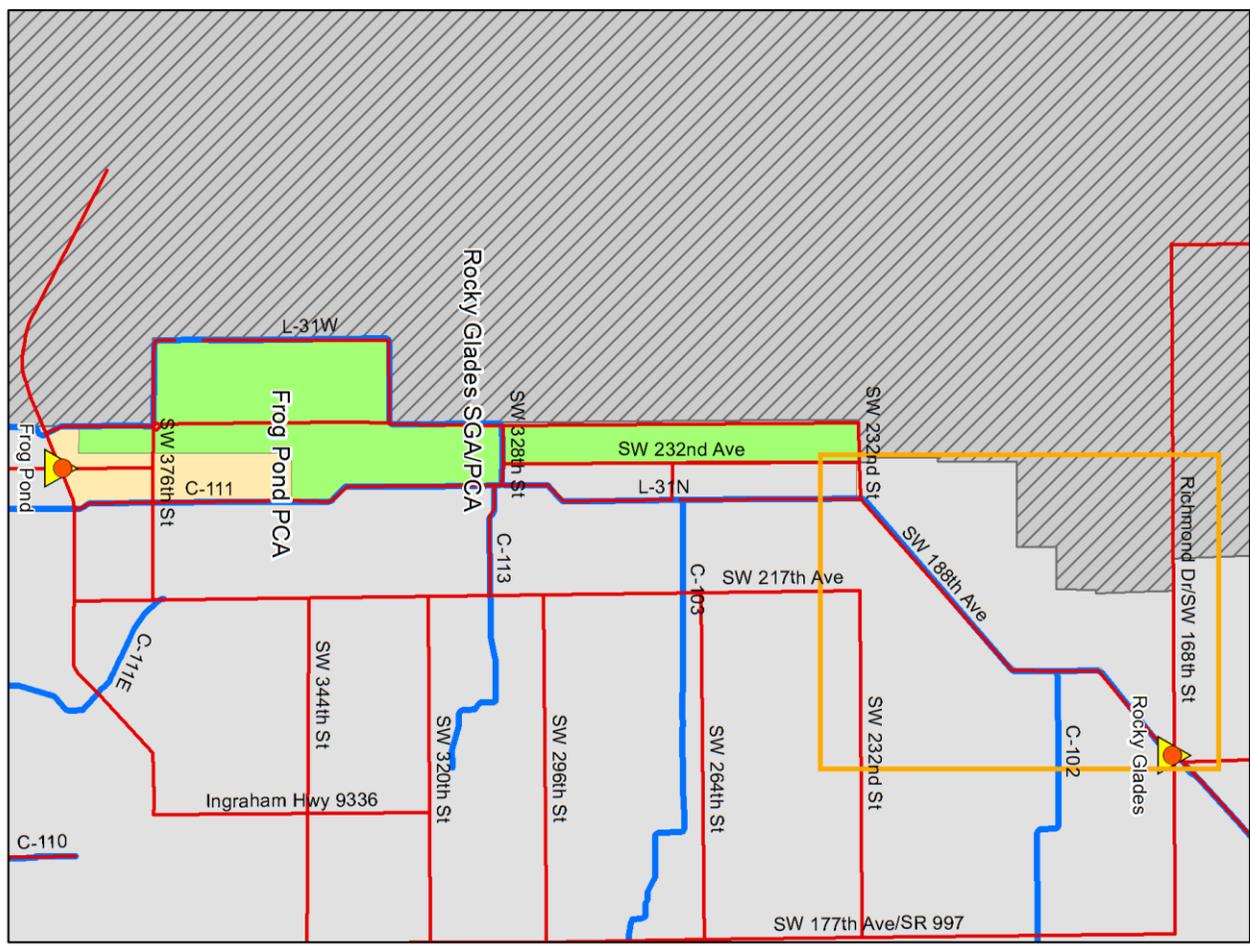

Rocky Glades Small Game Area/Python Challenge Area

Specific Area Rules

- a. Possession of a 2016 Python Challenge™ permit is required to participate in the Python Removal Competition portion of the 2016 Python Challenge™ and allows for the removal and transport of live or dead Burmese pythons. Python Challenge™ participants that have a 2016 Python Challenge™ permit do not need a hunting license and WMA permit or a Python Removal permit to capture, remove, harvest or transport live or dead Burmese pythons from the area.
- b. During weekdays, access is restricted to non-motorized means. A limited number of participants will be allowed access by vehicle on specified levees from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays on a first-come, first-served basis through gates located at [official drop off locations](#).
- c. Burmese pythons can be removed from ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset.
- d. **A [portion of this area](#) only allows for live capture of pythons.**
- e. For portions of the area where lethal removal is allowed, see [area regulations](#) regarding legal methods for taking pythons.
- f. Snake hooks, snake tongs, snake bags and long-handled non-motorized tools may be used to capture Burmese pythons.
- g. Use of traps, bait, explosives, chemicals, smoke and motorized tools is prohibited.
- h. Use of boats, airboats, ATVs, swamp buggies, tracked vehicles and unlicensed and unregistered motorcycles is prohibited.
- i. Use of vehicles off of levee roads is prohibited.
- j. Taking wildlife with a gun on, from or across levees or the right-of-way of roads is prohibited.

Frog Pond Small Game Area/Python Challenge Area

Specific Area Rules

- a. Possession of a 2016 Python Challenge™ permit is required to participate in the Python Removal Competition portion of the 2016 Python Challenge™ and allows for the removal and transport of live Burmese pythons. Python Challenge™ participants that have a 2016 Python Challenge™ permit do not need a hunting license and WMA permit or a Python Removal permit to capture, remove or transport live Burmese pythons from the area.
- b. During weekdays, access is restricted to non-motorized means. - i. Taking wildlife with a gun on, from or across levees or the right-of-way of roads is prohibited.
